

During the Triduum we celebrate the great gift of God's Love and Mercy made visible in the death and resurrection of Christ.

At times in our lives, we struggle to see that new life is available to us during great trials, suffering or disasters. Our fallen human nature wants us to despair, become angry with God or to abandon him entirely.

These holy days are not meant for us to simply observe but to enter the celebrations in such a way that with Christ we learn to abandon our lives completely to the Father, praying with Christ, 'not my will Lord but your will be done'. The only way that we can utter these words is if we have sacramentally, re-lived the passion and be strengthened through it.




The next CWL meeting will be held on Tuesday April 22, 2025, at St. Charles parish.
