**Holy Thursday** - Mass of the Lord's Supper, April 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

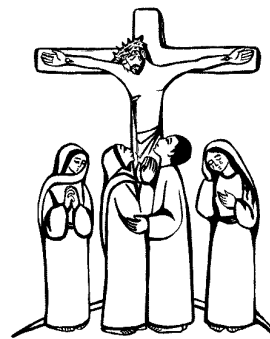
**Good Friday** – Passion of the Lord – April 18<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m.

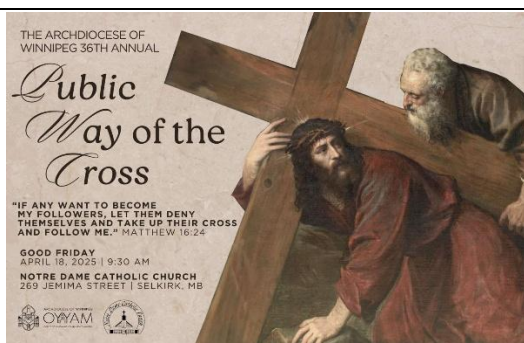
